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\*The following section from P.A. 89-4, eff. 1-1-19 (Senior Citizen Courses Act) describes the manner in which qualified senior citizens are determined.

§ 1 (c) "Senior citizen" means any person 65 years or older whose annual household income is less than the threshold amount provided in Section 4 of the "Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act"

\* The following sections from P.A. 77-2059 (Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act – repealed by 96-804, eff. 1-1-10) describe the manner in which "household income" is to be determined

403.05 Household defined

§ 3.05 "Household" means a claimant or a claimant and his or her spouse, if any, living together in the same residence.

403.6 Household income defined

§ 3.06 "Household Income" means the combined income of the members of a household

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
